



## Specifications:

- Posts and Header are 5.5" x 5.5:" White Oak 1/4" chamfer throughout.
  - Lower Tie Beam is mortice and tenon curved Cherry
  - Braces are made of 2"x2" White Oak
- Principal timber joints secured with White Oak or Locust Pegs
- Posts to be buried 4' below grade, backfilled with 3/4" crushed stone.

## Design:

- TimberHomes can facilitate contact with a graphic designer, however TimberHomes does not do this work in house
- TimberHomes will gladly work with your designer, if you have one, and will proceed only after a proof has been accepted
  - Display panels can be made of either:
    - High Pressure Laminate Sign with metal supporting plate-
    - Or, a two part PVC panels with aluminum "U" trim
- TimberHomes does not manufacture display panels, rather they are subcontracted to professional sign makers

## Display Panel Pricing:

- Display Panels are done on a per case basis. The size of the Display Panel can be easily changed, however its price varies greatly depending upon a sign's square footage and shipping
- Display panel pricing has historically been between \$100-\$200 per Sq. ft.

## Signboard Structure Pricing:

- Pricing for the standard Interpretive Signboard's timber frame structure (post spread up to 3') are shown on the previous page is listed below.
- Stretching Post spreads of wider than 3' will incur an additional cost of \$300 to cover the necessary design time and extra material
